# The internal system of score calculation for the National Higher Education Scholarship at the University of Szeged Faculty of Agriculture

Students have completed 55 credits in one academic year and have a minimum 4.50 regular average may apply for a National Higher Education Scholarship according to the National Higher Education Scholarship Regulations of the University of Szeged.

## I. Outstanding academic achievement

1. *study average*: the arithmetic mean of the regular average of two semesters, calculated to two decimal places.

The final score shall be determined as follows: the arithmetic mean of the regular average of two semesters \* 14

## Maximum: 70 points

2. **Scores awarded for accredited foreign language certificates** (from languages different from the language of the training program) recorded in the Electronic Study System (Neptun).

Certificate of advanced level language examination, type "C" (oral and written)	2 points
Certificate of intermediate level/intermediate level language examination with professional specialisation, type "C" (oral and written)	2 points
Certificate of advanced level language examination, type "A" (oral) or "B" (written)	1 point

Points can only be awarded for one certificate per language and only for the higher level certificate.

### Maximum: 5 points

# II. Outstanding professional activities in the academic year in which the application is submitted

# Documented, certified research, publication:

article published / lecture held in a foreign language	5 points
article published / lecture held in Hungarian	3 points
poster (English / Hungarian)	1 point
participation in any research work	1 point
demonstrator status (2 semesters)	4 points
demonstrator status (1 semester)	2 points

One publication per research topic can be counted, the same article or poster in Hungarian and in a foreign language cannot be counted!

No points may be awarded for research carried out in an application for which the student receives a separate remuneration.

### Maximum: 5 points

# Participation in the National Scientific Competition for Students (OTDK, TDK)

1st place	5 points
2nd place	4 points
3rd place and special prize	3 points
Simple participation	2 points

Participations in the OTDK, TDK must be scored separately.

## Involvement in other, professional or academic competitions (documented and certified):

1st place	4 points
2nd place	3 points
3rd place and special prize	2 points
Simple participation	1 points

## Maximum: 10 points

## III. Points for public, sporting and other activities

Activity in faculty committees (Faculty Council, Study Board)	2 points
Certified outstanding sporting or cultural activity (choir, stage performance)	2 points
Activity in events organised by the university/ faculty (orientation activities,	
opening and leaving ceremonies, graduation ceremony, Hungarian Great Plain	
Animal Husbandry and Agricultural Days Exhibition and Fair)	2 points

No points may be awarded for membership of the Student Government (HÖK) and the Students' Union (SZÉK) or any other university organisations for which the student receives remuneration. Outstanding sports activities and achievements in competitions must be certified by the student's sports association.

Extra points may be awarded for participation in the Hungarian Great Plain Animal Husbandry and Agricultural Days Exhibition and Fair only if the student is not receiving a remuneration and is not on a weekly practice.

### Maximum: 10 points, but no more than 10% of the student's overall score

### I. + II. + III. altogether maximum: 100 points

In the case of a draw, the score obtained in Part I. (Outstanding academic achievement) shall be preferred, if this is also a draw then the study average shall be used to create the final ranking.
