

Dear Conference Participants,

In this circular, I would like to share with you some technical information about the conference venue, conference program, presentations and posters.

The **conference will be held at two locations** on April 18, the registration, plenary session and poster session will be held in the Fekete Sas Event Hall, while the afternoon parallel sessions will be held at the Faculty of Agriculture. The locations of the conference and the possibility of free parking can be found on the **Conference Venue link** (<https://mgk.u-szeged.hu/wellmann/conference-venue-2024>).

The **conference program** and schedule of regular and short presentations have been completed, they can be seen on the **Final program link** (<https://mgk.u-szeged.hu/wellmann/final-program-2024>). Both can be downloaded from the indicated links.

Registration starts at 8:30 CET (=Hungarian time). At registration, you can request the conference participation certificate, as well as pay the conference participation fee in cash only, if this was not done in advance by bank transfer.

We kindly ask that participants with a **regular presentation** prepare a 10-minute presentation so that there is an opportunity to ask questions afterward. In the case of a **short presentation**, 5 minutes are available, so we recommend planning a maximum of 5 slides. In order to avoid possible technical problems, those who come with a presentation should bring their presentation in **pdf format** in addition to the **pptx format**, both on a pendrive and uploaded to the internet (e.g. google drive). The presenters of the parallel sessions are requested to be at the location of the session at least 15 minutes before the start of the session, so that their presentation can be uploaded in advance.

Those who come with a **poster** are requested to put up their poster well before the opening and welcome speeches (10 am CET), where technical assistance will be available. Everyone must print out and bring their poster in advance, this is not possible at the venue. **The recommended poster format is A1** (the maximum is A0).

The organizing committee of the conference wishes everyone a good trip and a calm preparation.
